

AFROTC PROGRAM BY YEAR REQUIREMENTS

Year 1 (AS 100) - Freshman

All Cadets

- Must pass the Air Force Officer Qualification Test (AFOQT)
 - Minimum of 15 on Verbal and 10 on Quantitative
 - Only 2 shots to take, but can be waived in certain circumstances
- Must meet attendance requirements each semester of 80% of classes to include LLAB and PT
 - If you miss more than the maximum allowable classes you will automatically fail AFROTC and be dismissed or disenrolled from the program

Non-Scholarship Cadets / Not Contracted

- Must maintain full time student status of 12 Credit Hours or Greater (drop below 12 you become special student)
- Maintain a 2.0 TGPA
- Must Attempt or Pass the Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA)
 - Must Pass by the end of the Fall Term of your sophomore or AS200 year
- If minimum requirements met, cadet can be submitted for a DoDMERB and Scholarship Nomination
- Nothing less than a "C" in Aerospace studies classes

Scholarship Cadets / Contracted

- Must maintain full time student status of 12 Credit Hours or greater (drop below 12 and you will be awarded a conditional event)
- Maintain a 2.5 TGPA
- Must Pass the Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA) by the end of your first semester
- No "F" in a core class
- Nothing less than a "C" in Aerospace studies classes

Year 2 (AS200) - Sophomore

All Cadets

- Must pass the AFOQT or obtained waiver by this point
- Must pass the PFA in the fall Semester regardless of Scholarship or not
 - This is required to nominate for Entry Allocation (EA) to go to Field Training and continue in the program, if no EA granted you cannot continue in the program
- All Civil Involvement Waivers should be completed by this time to allow for EA nomination
- Must have a minimum of a 2.0 Cumulative GPA to be nominated for an EA
- Must meet attendance requirements each semester of 80% of classes to include LLAB and PT
 - If you miss more than the maximum allowable classes you will automatically fail AFROTC and be dismissed or disenrolled from the program

Non-Scholarship / Not Contracted

- Must Pass the PFA in the fall semester of AS200 year to be nominated for an EA
- Will be scheduled for a DoDMERB Physical to qualify you to continue in the program medically
 - Lots of issues can come up on the medical side and that is discussed later
- Must maintain a 2.0 TGPA
- Nothing less than a "C" in Aerospace studies classes

Scholarship / Contracted

- Must Pass the PFA in the fall semester of AS200 year to be nominated for an EA
- Must Maintain a 2.5 TGPA
- No "F" in a core class
- Nothing less than a "C" in Aerospace studies classes

Summer Programs for AS200 or Rising Junior (AS300)

- All AS200/250 Cadets who receive an EA will attend Field Training at Maxwell AFB, AL for either 4 or 5 weeks of intensive training in various subjects
- You will attend this training based on the Spring End Dates of classes and the Fall Start Date of Classes

Year 3 (AS300) - Junior

All Cadets

- Must have returned from Field Training with a Satisfactory rating or higher
- All Non-Contracted Cadets will be contracted and begin receiving stipend only
- Must meet attendance requirements each semester of 80% of classes to include LLAB and PT
 - If you miss more than the maximum allowable classes you will automatically fail AFROTC and be disenrolled from the program

Contracted / Non-Scholarship Cadets

- Must maintain a 2.0 TGPA
- Must Pass the PFA in all terms from here out in fail a conditional event will be awarded
- No "F" in a core class
- Nothing less than a "C" in Aerospace studies classes

Contracted / Scholarship Cadets

- Must maintain a 2.5 TGPA
- Must continue to pass the PFA
- No "F" in a core class
- Nothing less than a "C" in Aerospace studies classes

Year 4 (AS400) - Senior

All Cadets

- Should have or are currently filling a Cadet Wing Leadership Position (MANDATORY)
- Be preparing for Graduation/Commissioning unless in a 5 year degree path
- Must meet attendance requirements each semester of 80% of classes to include LLAB and PT
 - If you miss more than the maximum allowable classes you will automatically fail AFROTC and be disenrolled from the program

Contracted / Non-Scholarship Cadets

- Must maintain a 2.0 TGPA
- Must Pass the PFA in all terms from here out in fail a conditional event will be awarded
- No "F" in a core class
- Nothing less than a "C" in Aerospace studies classes

Contracted / Scholarship Cadets

- Must maintain a 2.5 TGPA
- Must continue to pass the PFA
- No "F" in a core class
- Nothing less than a "C" in Aerospace studies classes

Year 5 (Completed Cadets) AS700 or AS800

The difference between an AS700 and AS800 Cadet is money; if you are an AS700 cadet you are not receiving any money of any kind from AFROTC. If you are an AS800 cadet you are receiving at least a stipend if not more.
