

FIELD TRAINING

How do you best position yourself to get an Entry Allocation (EA) to attend Field Training?

Here at Detachment 592 we use the whole person concept to rank order all cadets based on a variety of categories. This allows for a fair and balanced view of each cadets performance with the program to date. The following is how the rankings are determined for each cadet:

Once you are selected for Field Training a new phase of the program begins and it starts with more paperwork. Below is what will happen shortly after you have been notified that you have received an EA to go to Field Training.

- You will setup an appointment with the Field Training NCO to complete the following paperwork
 - AF Hometown News Release
 - Direct Deposit Pay Form (**Bring Bank Routing # and Bank Account # for Checking or Savings / A blank check will work**)
 - Statement of Authorization
 - Serviceman's Group Life Insurance (SGLI)
 - 2009 W-4
 - Emergency Contact Data Information
 - Provide Immunizations Records with at least the following shots documented
 - MMR (measles, Mumps, Rubella), Varicella, and Meningococcal

You will also need to answer the following questions

1. Will you be taking any prescription medication to Field Training – If so you need to provide a letter from your Doctor who prescribed the medication?
2. Anybody using an inhaler for breathing purposes?
3. Do you have any Tattoos? **We will need to do an MFR for all Tattoo(s) on your body.**
 - a. If so where are they/it located?
 - b. What is the Tattoo of?
 - c. Will it be visible in your Fitness Uniform?

Later in the Semester you will receive your Field Training Assignment based on School start and stop dates. If you need to change your FT Assignment you must provide a good justification why you need it changed. Birthdays, Family Reunions etc will NOT be accepted. If you have academic reason they will be considered on a case by case basis, the best way to obtain an FT assignment change is to swap with another cadet. The Detachment will NOT research this for you, you will need to find another cadet who is willing to swap with you and provide that information to the Detachment FT NCO so they can forward it to HQ AFROTC for processing and approval.
