

MEDICAL

All AFROTC Cadets are required to have a physical on file while they are actively enrolled in the program.

Non-Scholarship/Not Contracted Cadets

- Required to obtain a sports physical from their Doctor or the school health center. (Not Required for Scholarship Cadets or those on Contract)

AS200 & AS250 Cadets

- Will be scheduled for a DoDMERB through the Medical NCO
- These 2 appointments are mandatory and any missed or no-show you will be counseled
- Takes 15 - 30 Days to find out results of Physical Exams

Remedials

- These are request from DoDMERB for more medical information on a specific diagnosis you annotated on the form
- While in Remedial status you are NOT eligible to participate in any type of PT with the cadet corps

Waivers

- DoDMERB goes by the book they only see black and white no grey or in-between so they will automatically DQ you for entry if the Air Force Instruction says to do so
- AETC/SGPS is the only waiver authority within the Air Force
- DoDMERB will send to them for them to review and grant or disapprove the waiver request

There are a lot of issues that the Air Force has determined ineligible but AETC/SGPS can waive if they determine it will not affect you or the Air Force. Once AETC/SGPS makes its determination their decision is final and you will either be able to continue in AFROTC or not.
