

MONEY

Only cadets who are on scholarship or are POC cadets get any type of money from AFROTC.

If you are a scholarship cadet you are having your school paid for by the Air Force, receiving a book stipend and a monthly living stipend, which are detailed below.

All Money listed is Per YEAR

Type 1 - (HSSP & ICSP ONLY) Provide full tuition and fees and \$900.00 in book money

Type 2 - Provides up to \$18,000.00 tuition and fees and \$900.00 in book money

Type 3 - (ICSP ONLY) Provides up to \$9,000.00 in tuition and fees and \$900.00 in book money

Type 6 - (ICSP ONLY) Provides up to \$3,000.00 in tuition and fees and \$900.00 in book money

Type 7 - (HSSP ONLY) Provides full tuition and fees and \$900.00 in book money

Type 8 - This is an upgrade to existing scholarship and covers 80% of tuition and fees and \$900.00 in book money

As noted above the descriptions are per year so if you have a Type 2 Scholarship your tuition and fees will be paid by semester and each semester you tuition and fees will be paid up to \$7,500.00 per semester. Your book money is also handed out per semester so it will be in increments of \$450.00 per semester.

Also as a contracted cadet you will receive a stipend or living allowance per month. This is distributed on a bi-weekly basis or as the military pays on the 1st and 15th of each month. Each AS year is given a specific amount as shown below:

AS100 - \$300.00 per month or \$150.00 on the 1st and \$150.00 on the 15th

AS200 - \$350.00 per month or \$175.00 on the 1st and \$175.00 on the 15th

AS300 - \$450.00 per month or \$225.00 on the 1st and \$225.00 on the 15th

AS400 - \$500.00 per month or \$250.00 on the 1st and \$250.00 on the 15th

AS800 - \$500.00 per month or \$250.00 on the 1st and \$250.00 on the 15th

All book and stipend monies are Direct Deposited into your checking or savings account, which ever you annotated on the direct deposit form.

GMC or General Military Course Cadets which are the AS100 and AS200 Cadets are only paid from the beginning of the Fall Semester to the last day of the Spring Semester. Once summer starts their monthly stipend stops for the summer. POC or Professional Officer Course Cadets which are AS300, AS400, AS800 cadets continue to get paid throughout the summer.

Standard Scholarship and Contracted Non-Scholarship Cadets are authorized 600 Days of pay for GMC and 600 Days of pay for POC. These 600 days will not come into play during your GMC years, however during your POC years as you get paid during the summer months this 600 day limit will come into play. What happens is 99 percent of POC cadets who are on a 4 year plan,

their 600 days will end about 1 month from graduation and commissioning so you will not be getting paid that last month.

Scholarship cadets who are in a 5 Year Approved Technical Major by the Secretary of the Air Force, not the school itself, can apply for extended term entitlements. This means at the end of your 4 year scholarship and if you have a 2.5 GPA or better you will automatically qualify to have your scholarship entitlements extended to cover your 5th year of school. This also means that your stipend will be extended an extra 300 days for a total of 900 days of stipend pay.

Cadets who attend FT during the summer get training pay which is taxable this training pay varies each year but remains around \$800.00 before taxes each year.

Cadets who attend a PDT during the summer also get training pay which is taxable but varies depending on the type of PDT you attend and the length.
