

## SCHOLARSHIPS

There are different programs of Scholarships and they are listed as follows:

**HSSP or High School Scholarship Program** - This is for Seniors in High School who will be attending a college or university in the fall after graduating high school and plan on commissioning in the Air Force.

**Requirements:**

- Must be a High School Senior who plans on attending College full-time the following fall
- Pass a Physical Fitness Assessment
- Go through an Interview process with an Air Force Officer

**ICSP or In-College Scholarship Program** - This is for current cadets in the AFROTC program who, either didn't get an HSSP or didn't apply for it, and who are now eligible to compete for the ICSP. There are 2 times this scholarship is awarded, in the Spring Semester and the Fall Semester.

**Requirements:**

- Must maintain a 2.5 CGPA
- Must have completed 1 full term of college classes at full time status
- Be a US Citizen
- Be 14 or older
- Meet Body Mass Index (BMI) Standards of 27.5 or less
- Pass PFA
- Passed the AFOQT
- Have a DoDMERB Scheduled
- Any and all waivers obtained from HQ AFROTC/RRFP
- Obtain US Citizenship by the date of activation of scholarship
- Take DLAB or Defense Language Aptitude Battery Test

**EXP or Express Scholarship** - This is for cadets in specific degree programs. These cadets do not compete against anyone, as long as they are medically qualified and have met the GPA requirements and are graduating in the required FY they are automatically awarded the scholarship.

**Requirements:**

- Same as ICSP but also be in the degree programmed for that Express Scholarship

**HBCU or Historically Black College and University** - This is for cadets going to an HBCU college such as Johnson C. Smith University in Charlotte NC. If you attend this school no matter the degree path and you are medically qualified and met the GPA requirements you will.

**Requirements:**

- Same as ICSP but also be attending a Historically Black College or University (HBCU)

**NSP or Nursing Scholarship** - This is for cadets who have been accepted into the full nursing program at their college, no competition, if all requirements are met they are awarded this scholarship.

**Requirements:**

- Same as ICSP but also be accepted into the full nursing program of school attending
